**Objectives:** Participants of the *JMD CME Program in Molecular Diagnostics* should be able to demonstrate an increase in, or confirmation of, their knowledge of the latest advances in molecular diagnosis and prognosis and understanding of molecular pathogenesis of disease after reviewing specific articles in *The Journal of Molecular Diagnostics (JMD)*.

**Participants:** This program is specifically developed for trainees, clinicians and researchers interested in the molecular basis of disease and the application of nucleic acid and protein assays for diagnostic and prognostic analysis of disease.

**CME Credit:** This activity has been planned and implemented in accordance with the Essential Areas and policies of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) through the joint sponsorship of the Federation of American Societies for Experimental Biology (FASEB) and the American Society for Investigative Pathology (ASIP). **Deadline:** The deadline for receipt of the CME 2007 Registration Form and all Examination Answer Sheets is **February 1, 2008**.

1. Photocopy the Examination in the back of each print edition of *JMD*, or download at [www.amp.org/cme/exams.html](http://www.amp.org/cme/exams.html) or [www.asip.org/cme/exams.html](http://www.asip.org/cme/exams.html).
2. Fill in the appropriate circle to indicate your answer to each question.
3. Enter your name and email address.
4. Mail or fax the completed Examination Answer Sheet along with your CME Registration Form\* and payment to the AMP/ASIP JMD CME office. \*\* You may mail or fax your completed Examination Answer Sheet to the AMP/ASIP JMD CME office after each issue is published in order to receive correct answers within 1 month, **OR** you may collect your completed Examination Answer Sheets throughout the year, and mail or fax to the AMP/ASIP JMD CME office at the completion of the 2007 CME year. The deadline for receipt of the CME 2007 Registration Form, all Examination Answer Sheets, and the CME Evaluation Form is **February 1, 2008**.
