Weill Cornell Medical Center / New York-Presbyterian Hospital Molecular Genetic Pathology Fellowship

Description of Program and Additional Information:

The Molecular Genetic Pathology (MGP) Program at the Weill Cornell Medical College New York-Presbyterian Hospital is currently accepting applications for the 2012-2013 academic year. This newly ACGME-accredited one-year fellowship provides structured training in all aspects of molecular pathology, including laboratory management, testing development and clinical consultation. The fellow will assume progressive responsibility for the diagnosis of a wide variety of genetic, infectious, and oncologic diseases. The program also provides rotations in cytogenetics and pre-implementation genetic diagnosis (PGD) laboratories. Techniques available include automated nucleic acid extraction, real-time PCR, capillary electrophoresis, sequencing, conventional cytogenetics and FISH. Trainees are expected to attend genetics clinic and relevant clinical conferences, participate in test development and residents teaching.
