Cedars-Sinai Medical Center Molecular Genetics Pathology Fellowship Program

Description of Program:

The program is structured to provide core training over a one-year period to assure the learning of all techniques and skills needed for excellence of practice in and administration of molecular genetics pathology (MGP). The MGP fellow learns how to select, apply and interpret molecular and array studies, and create cogent and integrative reports in a variety of areas including hematopathology, infectious diseases, solid tumors, inherited diseases, pharmacogenomics, genetics, and cytogenetics. This program is closely affiliated with the CSMC Medical Genetics residency program and the two share several educational forums. Thus, MGP fellows who are pathologists spend one month in a [Medical Genetics Clinical rotation](#), a month in the cytogenomics rotation, and attend a year-long broad based Medical Genetics course. Those from internal medicine with medical genetics training spend a month on the autopsy service. The overall goal is for the fellow to acquire the medical knowledge, diagnostic skills, and experience needed to practice as an outstanding molecular pathologist. The fellow also will gain research experience and skills allowing the option of developing a successful academic career, as well as experience in educating pathology colleagues and clinicians in molecular genetics pathology.
